

Statement of Representations Procedure for the Chiltern District Council and the South Bucks District Council Community Infrastructure Levy Draft Charging Schedules

COMMUNITY INFRASTRUCTURE LEVY REGULATIONS 2010 (AS AMENDED)

A draft charging schedule has been prepared by Chiltern District Council and a separate draft charging schedule has been prepared by South Bucks District Council under the above Regulations. All representations received on the Chiltern District Council - South Bucks District Council – Draft Charging Schedules will be submitted to an Independent Examiner and considered as part of a public examination. Please note that copies of all accepted representations will be made available for the public to view (including your name but not your contact details) and cannot be treated as confidential. Therefore, in making your comments you consent to your minimum information being published.

Document Title	Chiltern District Council - South Bucks District Council – Draft Charging Schedules
Subject matter	The Community Infrastructure Levy (CIL) Draft Charging Schedule (DCS) is the second of the consultations required as part of the process leading to the introduction of CIL in the areas administered by Chiltern District Council and South Bucks District Council. This follows from an initial consultation on a CIL Preliminary Draft Charging Schedule (PDCS) which was held from November to December 2018.
Area covered	Separate Draft Charging Schedules for Chiltern District Council and South Bucks District Council.
Consultation Period	Representations regarding the CIL must be made and received by the Councils during the consultation period: Midday on Friday 7 June until midnight on 23 August 2019
Your rights	Persons making representations may request the right to be heard by the examiner. Representations may be accompanied by a request to be notified at a specified address of any of the following;

	<p>(i) that the draft charging schedule has been submitted to the examiner in accordance with section 212 of Planning Act 2008,</p> <p>(ii) the publication of the recommendations of the examiner and the reasons for those recommendations, and</p> <p>(iii) the approval of the charging schedule by the charging authority.</p> <p>You may withdraw your representations at any time by giving the Councils written notice.</p>
